If you are interested in Weekly Collections:

We estimate that Envelopes, Gift Aid and Standing Orders add up to a weekly total of around £570. It is difficult to be precise as some of these arrive irregularly, others weekly or monthly, and some annually. Giving loose in the weekly Mass collection fluctuates according to season, for example

August 13 - Tisbury £164.50, Wardour £142.75, Wardour 2nd (chapel trustees) £19.36, Envelopes £85.00.

August 20 - Tisbury £169.92, Wardour £142.75, Wardour 2nd (chapel trustees) £22.00, Envelopes £35.00.
